- Andrew made a motion to accept the new members of the Board of Election, Chaz Schneider, chair. Dave seconded. The motion carried.
- Brandon made a motion to accept the Auditor: Barbacane. Dave seconded. All in favor.
  The motion carried.
- Budget 2016-17 Operating Budget was discussed. There were no major points of discussion or disagreement.
- Dave made a motion to accept the tax rate at .55. Andrew seconded. All in favor. The motion carried.
- Brandon made a motion to accept the 2016-17 Operating Budget with \$245,400 in Receipts and \$277,250 in Expenses. Dave seconded. All in favor. The motion carried.
