Candidate Qualifications:

- All positions must be Citizen of the Town of Bellefonte
- Treasurer must also be a freeholder (property owner)
- Must not have been convicted of a felony
- At least 21 years of age by date of election
- Qualified voter for at least 1 year

How to File for Candidacy:

Submit a letter or other certificate to the Chair of the Board of Elections declaring candidacy for a designated position. This may be a simple written statement of your intent to run, or you may use the sample filing form which can be obtained on the Town website at www.townofbellefonte.com.
