Call to Order: Dave called the meeting to order at 7:07 pm

Special Guest/Public Comment: NCC Councilman John Cartier code enforcement report 17, 9 resolved as of October 11. Crime report is now presented as crime mapping, using GPS coordinates. John said that one good piece of news if that both County and State finances are doing well and so we may not face a budget crisis next year.

Minutes to the Previous Meeting: Brandon made a motion to waive the reading and to approve the minutes to the previous meeting as distributed, Dave seconded, and the motion was approved unanimously.

Board of Adjustment – No report.

Planning Commission/ZRB – Carol Dougherty reported that the Planning Commission is reviewing the feedback of the Comprehensive Plan from the PLUS review committee. The Comp Plan will need review by NCC and the City of Wilmington before submission. There was one ZRB review, a permit for 703 Brandywine Blvd. for an interior renovation.

Treasurer/Tax Collector's Report: Curt presented the financial report as of November 30. (Attached). Dave noted that we are fairly close to budget for the year so far. Curt agreed that we are running pretty close to our budget for the year. Scott made a motion to approve the report, seconded by Brandon, and the motion was approved.

Curt presented a list of delinquent taxes and the associated amounts. The Commissioners discussed what threshold would be a good amount to ask the Town solicitor to take action on. Scott made a motion to instruct the Town attorney to place a monition on properties with more than \$2,000 in delinquent taxes as of January 1, 2018, seconded by Brandon, and the vote was unanimous. Scott will contact Bill Gonser and notify him of the decision and Curt will send the list after January 1 so that the list will include delinquent taxes from the current year.
