### Town of Bellefonte, Delaware Town Meeting Minutes, February 10, 2025

Attending: Brandon Dougherty, Dave Brenner, Scott MacKenzie, Andrew Ritchie, and Logan Ritchie and Treasurer and Tax Collector Curt Nass.

**Call to Order/Welcome** – Brandon called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

**Minutes to the Previous Meeting** – Andrew made a motion to waive the reading and to accept the minutes as distributed, seconded by Dave, and all approved.

Scott motioned to reorder the agenda to bills, seconded by Logan, and approved by all. Scott read two invoices for snowplowing service from Finocchiaro and Brothers for \$5,425.00 and \$2,585.00. Scott made a motion to pay these two bills, seconded by Logan and all approved.

Scott made a motion to rejoin normal order of the agenda, seconded by Brandon, and all approved.

#### **Committee Reports:**

**Board of Adjustments** – No activity.

**Planning Commission/Zoning Review Board** – No update. PC did meet on 2/3 and did approve one ZRB application.

**Treasurer's Report and Tax Collector's Report** – Curt presented the Financial Statements of account as on January 31 (attached) and the Report on Delinquent Taxes. Scott made a motion to approve Financial Reports as presented, seconded by Andrew, and all approved.

#### **Old Business/President's Report:**

Town Hall Complex improvements – Status Report from Scott. Automatic door in stairwell has been ordered by Deldeo and will be installed by mid-March. Roof brackets for new solar panels have been ordered and the roofer has been notified that delivery is pending. Roofer and Sun in One have been connected so that the new roof installation can proceed. Both roofing and solar racks may be installed before the March meeting, dependent on weather.

**Review of Capital Improvements** Budget - Scott reported that after the project approval of the January meeting, there will be approximately \$500 left from the DE Community Reinvestment Fund, which will most likely be used to fix Edison lights on the Blvd.

**Sidewalks and Streetlights** – Nothing to report on sidewalks on Bellefonte Ave., the contractor has been notified to proceed with two new lampposts.

**Shops of Bellefonte** – Status Report. Tonya Smallwood of Lotus Lane attended as well as Valerie White of Bellefonte Arts. Tonya reported that the Shops will be having the Earth Day Spring Flea on Saturday April 12. She requested sponsorship for the event in support of advertising and porta potties. Scott made a motion to approve \$300 for sponsorship of Spring Flea. April 12, Earth Day, seconded by Brandon, and approved by all.

Valerie reported that the Bellefonte Arts Festival would be held on Saturday, May 17 and requested sponsorship of bathrooms and wash stations. Scott made a motion to approve up to \$525 for sponsorship of bathrooms for Bellefonte Arts Festival, seconded by Brandon, and all in favor.

**Energy and Community Development Grant** – Status Report. No communication from DNREC since sending signed contract, but Scott said it may be waiting on confirmation of the new DNREC secretary.
